What is the ASPIRE Program?

After School Programs Providing Intervention, Recreation, and Enrichment available to students in grades Kindergarten through 6th Grade:

Intervention: small group tutoring and/or homework support

Recreation: structured sports, games, and supervised free play

Enrichment: crafts, cooking, leadership training, character education and more

Monday thru Friday

Every School Day

- Due to ASES funding, students at Cloverland, Fair Oaks, and Magnolia who are identified by the site principal for academic intervention may attend at no cost.
- Students not identified by the site principal for academic intervention may attend the program for a fee:
- \$85 per month for the first child and \$55 per month for each additional child.
- SIERRA VIEW does NOT receive ASES funding. Therefore, there is NO free program available at Sierra View.

COST

Payments are due on the 1st of each month. A \$10 late fee will apply if received after the 5th.

- ◆ Before School Childcare: \$35 per month per child for the first child and \$20 per month for each additional child.
- ◆ ASPIRE providing after school tutoring, homework support, recreation, and enrichment is \$85 per month per child for the first child and \$55 per month for each additional child.
- ◆ For families on Free or Reduced Lunch the Before School Recreation Program fee is \$20 per month for the first child and \$10 per month for each additional child.
- ◆ For families on Free or Reduced Lunch the ASPIRE fee is \$55 per month per child for the first child and \$31 per month for each additional child.

REGISTRATION

Registration for 2011-2012 ASPIRE for all elementary sites will open up on July 11, 2011. In order to register your child and reserve their spot:

1. Complete a the ASPIRE Registration Packet available at the district office, which is located at 168 South 3rd Avenue, or print an ASPIRE Registration Packet from the district website at: <http://www.oakdale.k12.ca.us/curriculum/Categorical/ASP.htm>

IMPORTANT: If your child is identified by their site principal for specific academic intervention and consequently, no fee is required, you will be notified of this by the end of August 2011. No fees will be required for your child from September onward. Children *not* identified for specific academic intervention may continue to attend for the monthly fee.
